A Letter from Linda

November found me working on Minnesota Unit and Region 7 paperwork and since this is the month 'to be thankful' - I'm thanking my Airstream Friends. I couldn't have done this without you.

Unit Constitution and Bylaws Update

Our three Units of Region 7 are at that five year mark when their Constitutions and Bylaws need to be updated. We need to bring them into the computer age so we may use email as an official means of communication. Unit members will soon be asked to vote on these updates. Please send back your vote as no response means a 'NO' vote. Directions where to send will be on your ballot.

Unit Merit Awards

Another important task for the Region President is to review each unit's Merit Award paperwork.

What is Merit Award paperwork? Each new unit president faces the challenge of planning, coordinating and documenting the many unit events that will take place during his or her term. At the end of the term, this completed paperwork, known as the Unit Merit Award Guide, is reviewed by the region president, then submitted to the WBCCI Merit Award Program Coordinator. These preformatted "Unit Merit Award" documents identify the many activities, each with an associated point value, the unit is expected to accomplish. Some of these activities are administrative, most are social and fun...rallies, caravans, luncheons, etc. The more activities accomplished, the more points earned. Quite often, a unit president doesn't get around to filling out this official documentation until he's completed his term. He has 60 days from his end of term to submit the completed forms. The Region president helps each unit president get it done, then submits the completed information to the WBCCI Coordinator. When a unit has earned enough points (at least 2000) during a president's term a Merit Award is issued. If a unit has earned 4000 points or more, a Superior Merit Award is issued. Have you seen the ribbons attached to the top of our unit's Flag Pole

at the opening ceremonies at the International and/or Regional rallies? Each Blue Streamer/Ribbon represents a Unit Merit Award; a Gold Streamer/ Ribbon represents a Unit Superior Merit Award.

I'm very proud to announce that Region 7's North Dakota Peace Garden Unit has earned a Unit Superior Merit Award. Congratulations to 2012 Unit President Beth Zinc and all NDPG members.

I mentioned earlier that all too often, a Unit's Merit Award activities aren't documented until the end of the president's term. But the true purpose of the Unit Merit Award Guide worksheets is to help the president plan the many activities a unit should be doing. It may identify an activity he didn't realize had award points associated with it, or identify one he may not have considered. Each Unit's first vice-presidents should already be reviewing the Guide.

Unit Officer Training Guide

I've been rewriting and updating the Region Training Guide with a lot of help from 'my friends'. It will be ready for the 2013 Region Rally. If you have the 2012 Training Guide and are no longer an officer, please pass it on to a new officer or to me so I may include new information. This will save the Region money in printing costs.

2013 Region 7 Tall Ships Rally

Now for the fun part. Plans are well under way for the Region 7 Rally in Duluth - The Festival of the Tall Ships. Once again, this will be a joint rally of the Region 7 and the Region 7 Vintage Airstream Club. We had so much fun at Spicer, Curt Gunderson and I decided to continue a good thing. Wonder if the cheese head will be there?? In the near future, a rally flyer will be included in your newsletter and on the Region web site: http://www.region7.wbcci.net/.


