

#### Marquette Rally Update

**Members attending the Marquette rally August 16-18 need to get their campground fees into host Jane Carmichael by April 15. See registration form page 8.**

First, thanks to everyone in the Wisconsin Unit who has reserved, and more importantly, has sent in their campsite fee! The \$32 per night covers the full hookup campsite cost. We will all be in the same area and they are the more “primo” sites at Tourist Park, located in the city limits of Marquette, MI. Shower house is nearby and a map will be in the June newsletter.

Secondly, the per-person Rally Fee is \$10. The \$10 covers the cost of the Saturday night Pasty Dinner and the cost of firewood. As you know, you are not allowed to move wood into the Upper Peninsula, due to the spread of the nasty Emerald Ash Borer. We must buy it from the concessionaire, no exceptions. There will be campfires every night, weather permitting. **Please pay rally fee(s) to Unit Treasurer Sandy Emerick in advance. See registration form, page 8.**

Thirdly, for everyone (limit 19) who wants to go on the Saturday morning “Tour of Marquette”, there will be a fee of \$25 per person. The Checker Bus Company is providing the coach and Fred Huffman, who has run Marquette County tours for over twenty-five years, is our Tour Guide. The “Tour of Marquette” bus will pick you up at at 10:30 AM Eastern Time on Saturday, August 17. The tour will be about 2 1/2 hours.

### Proposed Constitutional Amendment

There is only one proposed amendment to the WBCCI International Constitution this year, essentially the same Non-Airstream Motor Home amendment that was proposed last year. The 2012 Delegates Meeting sent the proposed amendment to the International Constitution & Bylaws Committee for correction of technical difficulties, and it has returned for a vote this year.

Amendment 1 is reprinted in its entirety on pages 6 and 7 of this newsletter. Essentially it would allow a WBCCI Life Member, or members who had been members for at least 10 years, to remain full members and participate in rallies and caravans in a Thor Class A motor home.

Please read the amendment as proposed, but note that there were **several** changes to the amendment proposed at last year's Delegates Meeting, so we really don't know what form will finally be voted upon at the Delegate's Meeting.

Having informed themselves on the candidates and this issue, all Wisconsin Unit members are urged to vote their wishes, preferably by attending the April 27 membership meeting at Wisconsin Dells or by mailing in the ballot contained on page 5 of this newsletter.

### Statement on the Motor Home Amendment

In the newsletter you will find the proposed amendment to the International Constitution regarding making non-Airstream owners eligible for membership in WBCCI. This issue has been raised before and has been rejected by the membership when it has been brought forward. Please express your opinion by attending the April Campout and meeting in the Dells, or by sending in your ballot from the newsletter. I will be representing the Unit at the International and wish to properly express the views of our membership.

I belong to the Good Sam Club as well as WBCCI. I receive much good information and many helpful items through Good Sam. I belong to WBCCI because my Airstream trailer is a unique vehicle and other Airstream owners help me find ways to maintain and repair my trailer as well as being a fun group. That knowledge is not available from mainstream camping clubs. I strongly believe that honoring the legacy of Wally Byam includes keeping WBCCI an Airstream only club. **I further believe that opening membership to non-Airstream owners will cause a drastic drop in membership of local units.** I strongly recommend against the adoption of this Constitutional Amendment.

## **Amendment No. 1**

### **Proposed by: Delegates**

As instructed by the Delegates at the June 30, 2012, meeting , the following amendment has been reviewed and revised by the WBCCI Constitution and Bylaws Committee.

Amend the WBCCI Constitution, Article VI (Title: Qualifications of Membership), Section 1, by inserting after "Airstream, Inc." and before the words "shall be.." the following: **or a class A motor home manufactured by Thor Industries, Inc., beginning with the 2007 model year,**  
and  
at the end of this section, add the following: **Ownership of a Thor manufactured class A motor home shall be by a LIFE or a minimum 10 year member.**

Section 1 would then read as follows:

An adult who owns a hard sided recreational vehicle manufactured by Airstream, Inc., **or a class A motor home manufactured by Thor Industries, Inc., beginning with the 2007 model year,** shall be eligible for membership. **Ownership of a Thor manufactured class A motor home shall be by a LIFE or minimum 10 year member.**

and

Insert in Section 2.B of this Article after the words "Airstream, Inc.," and before "as defined in this article" the following: **or Thor Industries, Inc.,**

Section 2.B would then read as follows: Ownership, except as provided herein, of a recreational vehicle manufactured by Airstream, Inc., **or Thor Industries, Inc.,** as defined by this Article, and the payment of annual Unit and International dues to a Unit is prerequisite to retaining membership as a regular member.

(The changing of Section 2.C is not recommended at this time.)

Further, the WBCCI Constitution and Bylaws Committee recommends the amendment of the WBCCI Constitution, Article III (Title: Visions, missions and Objectives), Section 1, by inserting between the words "for Airstream" and the word "owners.," the following: **and specified Thor.**

Section 1 would then read as follows:

**Vision Statement.** Wally Byam Caravan Club International, Inc. maintains its unique position of strength and visibility among recreational vehicle organizations as the recreational vehicle club of choice for Airstream **and specified Thor** owners.

and

In Section 2 of the same Article, insert between the words “of Airstream” and the words “owners” the following: **and specified Thor**.

Section 2 would then read as follows:

**Mission Statement.** Wally Byam Caravan Club International, Inc. is a diverse community of Airstream **and specified Thor** owners with a commitment to Fun, Fellowship and Adventure.

#### RATIONALE

The basic issue on this proposed amendment appears to be whether to keep the Club “pure” Airstream or give primary consideration to “membership”. The intent of this proposed amendment has these purposes:

1. An attempt to win back former WBCCI members who have chosen the motor home lifestyle either by desire or physical requirements due to the fact that since the 2006 model year Airstream no longer manufactures class A motor homes.
2. To provide a suitable choice for current Airstream class A owners who would prefer to have a newer RV.
3. To establish a business relationship with a second Thor Industries Company for the purpose of shared interests and resources to the mutual benefit of WBCCI, Airstream and Thor Motor Coach Company.
4. Continue to maintain our present status as an independently owned corporation with a willingness to diversify our member base by selected non-Airstream products within the Thor Industries umbrella as only towable Airstreams and class B motorized vehicles are now produced by the Airstream Company, and therefore, not limit our membership to a reduced portion of the RV public.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

If not passed, none. If passed, a reasonable increase in membership resulting in increased income.
