WBCCI Constitutional Amendments

The Midwinter IBT meeting was quite busy. A number of far-reaching changes were adopted, and constitutional amendments will be sent to the 2014 Delegates Meeting.

Motions passed at the Winter IBT were summarized in last month's *Badger Bulletin*. The complete minutes are now available on the WBCCI web site at

Three of the motions that were passed by the IBT propose amendments to the WBCCI constitution. These amendments will be taken up by the Delegates Meeting at the 2014 International Rally. Wisconsin Unit will vote on them at the April business meeting.

Briefly, the three proposed amendments would:

- 1. Establish that International units [Australia] will be part of an existing Region.
- 2. Expand the possible dates of the International Rally from June 20 to July 30.
- 3. Allow electronic renewal of Unit and International dues.

The full text of the proposed amendments will be published in the *Badger Bulletin*, along with a mail ballot.

Capital Campout Lake Farm Campground Madison, Wisconsin May 16 – 18, 2014




The *Capital Campout* rally in Madison will be at the Lake Farm County Park, 3113 Lake Farm Road, Madison, WI 53711, (608) 242-4576. This Dane County park has approximately forty sites available for campers. Further information at the park web site,

Make Reservations ASAP!

We were not able to arrange for sites to be held for us, so please make your reservations as soon as possible for a fun weekend. The park has only 38 campsites with electricity, and the rally will be the same weekend as the nearby Stoughton, Wisconsin *Syttende Mai* (Norwegian Independence Day) festival, which may increase the demand for campsites.



Steve & Lynne Piotrowski have reserved Site #50 and Dave Sherman &Vicki Engelstad have reserved Site #48. As of February 22, the loop containing sites 41, 44, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52 is booked up for the weekend of the rally. However, other sites are available, and you can reserve any site in the park and not be far from the action. The campground is not very big.

There is a non-refundable \$10 reservation fee. Electric sites are \$26 a night. Reservations are not refundable; in the event of a cancellation, you get credit for a future stay.

Depending on what you want to do, some additional permits may be required. See the park web site link for details. The complete fee schedule can be downloaded at

Dane County parks require a dog permit for dogs in the campground. One-day permits are available for \$5 per dog per day or you can buy an annual permit for \$30 for the first dog plus \$14 for each additional dog. Senior and handicapped discounts available—see fee schedule.

The park is on the state bike trail and a State Trail Pass is needed to ride on the trail. (Annual \$20, daily \$4.)

The park is located on the Madison Area bike trail, and we hope to have the Capitol Pedaler available to help us tour the city and its sights.



(Editorial note: The Capitol Pedaler, a.k.a. "The Big Red Bike" is essentially a tram powered by all the passengers pedaling. (Who steers?!) Think of it as a "Bicycle Built for Fourteen".)

Details on the entire weekend will be posted as we get closer, but expect a great time in our capital city. If you can get away, plan on arriving Thursday and staying through Sunday.


